We exist to glorify and enjoy the triune God of Scripture through worship, nurture, and witness.



Sermon Series: The Ten Points of Calvinism, #7 Sermon Text: 1 Samuel 16:1–23: "Baptism" Key words for kids: jersey, wax, mirror, Canaanites, free agent, coach Introduction

1. What is baptism?

Westminster Confession of Faith 28.1: Baptism is a sacrament of the New Testament, ordained by Jesus Christ,(1) not only for the solemn admission of the party baptized into the visible church;(2) but also, to be unto him a sign and seal of the covenant of grace,(3) of his ingrafting into Christ,(4) of regeneration,(5) of remission of sins,(6) and of his giving up unto God, through Jesus Christ, to walk in newness of life.(7) Which sacrament is, by Christ's own appointment, to be continued in his church until the end of the world.(8)

2. Who should be baptized?

Westminster Larger Catechism #166: Unto whom is baptism to be administered? Baptism is not to be administered to any that are out of the visible church, and so strangers from the covenant of promise, till they profess their faith in Christ, and obedience to him,(1) but infants descended from parents, either both or but one of them professing faith in Christ, and obedience to him, are, in that respect, within the covenant, and to be baptized.(2)
